**Howard Hertz**, co-founder of Bloomfield Hills-based **Hertz, Schram P.C.**, was recently recognized for two legal honors.

For the second consecutive year, Hertz was named one of Michigan's "Super Lawyers" by Law & Politics in its 2007 issue of Michigan Super Lawyers® as an Entertainment and Sports Law practitioner. He was also selected for inclusion in the "Best Lawyers in America" 2008.
